

Super Word Scramble

Tile distribution (100 total tiles):

A-9	H-2	O-8	V-2
B-2	I-9	P-2	W-2
C-2	J-1	Q-1	X-1
D-4	K-1	R-6	Y-2
E-12	L-4	S-4	Z-1
F-2	M-2	T-6	Blanks-2
G-3	N-6	U-4	

Points values:

1 point: A, E, I, O, U, L, N, S, T, R

2 points: D, G

3 points: B, C, M, P

4 points: F, H, V, W, Y

5 points: K

8 points: J, X

10 points: Q, Z

Rules

1. Draw tiles to start; player closest to A goes first.
2. Return the tiles to the draw pile and choose 7 new tiles.
3. After you play tiles, draw to replace them, maintaining 7 tiles as long as there are enough in the draw pile.
4. You can build words horizontally and vertically but not diagonally.
5. There are no premium letter scores. However, if you use all 7 tiles in one turn, you score a bonus 50 points in addition to your word score.
6. You can exchange any number of your tiles as long as there are still 7 in the draw stack.
7. Blank tiles stay the same letter for the entire game.
8. The game ends when all letters have been drawn and one player uses his/her last letter, or when all possible plays have been made.
9. When the game ends, each player's score is reduced by the sum of his or her unplayed letters. Plus, if a player has used all of his/her letters, the sum of the other players' unplayed letters is added to that player's score.
10. The player with the highest final score wins the game. In case of a tie, the player with the highest score before adding or deducting unplayed letters wins.
